#### **ABOUT FNCSI**

FNCSI is a not for profit, non-political, non-governmental Business Membership Organization (BMO). It has its networks all over Nepal, it compasses through District Chapters. Individual MCSI can get the General Membership at the District Chapters; so far there are about 35,000 general members of FNCSI in all District Chapters. Beside the general members and District Chapters, FNCSI's membership comprises of Institutional Membership, Associate Members and Co-operative members. Till the date there are 20 Institutional Members as the National level Commodity Associations and or Federations. And these all have their own general members and chapters in the districts.
